In the evening, you have the option to attend the Sound and Light Show at Karnak, an immersive way to experience this legendary site after dark.

Later, you'll catch your flight to Cairo, where you'll be transferred to a 5-star hotel for an overnight stay, continuing your enriching Egypt shore excursion from Safaga Port.
