Explore Luxor's East Bank with Light Show at Karnak | Day Trip from Safaga

When you arrive at Safaga Port, our representative will meet you and transfer you to Luxor to begin your exciting Egypt tour. Your trip begins at the massive [Karnak Temple](#), known as the largest man-made religious complex in the world. The site includes the largest hypostyle hall ever built, constructed by King Ramses II.

The temple was developed over more than two thousand years by several generations of pharaohs and features Hatshepsut's obelisk, the tallest standing obelisk in Egypt. Afterward, visit the stunning Luxor Temple, built mainly by New Kingdom pharaohs. This Southern Sanctuary played a major role during the annual Opet Festival.

Your Luxor day tour concludes with the captivating sound and light show at Karnak Temple, before heading back to your cruise at Safaga Port as part of your unforgettable Egypt shore excursion.
