Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive at Luxor

Meet our representative at Luxor Airport or Railway Station and transport to embark on the Blue Shadow Nile Cruise Tours Luxor to Aswan. Enjoy an open buffet lunch. Begin your Egypt Day Tours with a visit to Karnak Temple, one of Egypt's landmarks.

Then, continue to Luxor East Bank Tours to the great Luxor Temple, built during the new kingdom and characterized by huge temples that reflect the prosperity of the Egyptian Kingdom at the time, especially during the reign of Ramses II. Enjoy afternoon tea and the Belly Dance Show.

Dinner on the cruise ship and overnight at Luxor.

Day 2: Luxor Tour - Sail to Edfu

Breakfast will be served on board the cruise ship, followed by Luxor West Bank Tours. Visit the Valley of the Kings, the royal necropolis during the New Kingdom, and resume Luxor excursions to the temple of Queen Hatshepsut at El-Deir El-Bahari Temple. Hatshepsut was the second female ruler in ancient Egypt and had a strong personality to rule such a large Kingdom.

The history of Egypt tells us of many successful restorations done by her government in all fields. Now it's time to tour. Sail to Esna and have lunch on the cruise ship before the afternoon tea and Captain's Welcome Cocktail Party. Dinner and stay at Esna.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples - Sail to Aswan

After breakfast, we will visit the temple dedicated to the god Horus in Edfu. We will then sail along the Nile to Kom Ombo, where we will have a gourmet lunch and afternoon tea before visiting the Kom Ombo Temples dedicated to the two gods, which your specialist tour guide will explain in detail.

Finally, we will sail to Aswan.

Dinner and stay in Aswan.

Day 4: Aswan Tour

They will be served breakfast buffet aboard the cruise ship in Aswan and start Aswan tours by visiting the High Dam, which has always secured Egypt in the modern world from the annual floods that the Nile River causes, the Unfinished Obelisk at the granite quarries, understanding about how huge pillars, stones, and obelisks were cut and shifted to construct gargantuan Pyramids during the old kingdom and temples that were built during the new Kingdom. Grab a scrumptious meal for dinner as you watch the Nubian Folkloric Show.
